

REIMBURSEMENT FOR USAGE

Since there are costs involved in maintaining these facilities, any group using these accommodations, should adhere to the following guidelines:

1. A group using the facilities overnight should contribute a donation of \$3.00 per person per night per individual, with a minimum donation of \$40.00.

	Amount Due
Example = 25 individuals X \$3.00 = \$75.00	\$75.00
Example = 10 individuals X \$3.00 = \$30.00	\$40.00

2. A group using the facilities for day use should contribute a minimum donation of \$1.00 per person with a minimum donation of \$30.00.
3. Any group using the electric heating unit, will be charged \$15.00 per day/night for its usage. Two days/nights would be \$30.00.
4. The member of the association who sponsors the visiting group should receive a service fee of \$25.00 in addition to the group's fee, for his time.

USAGE OF FACILITIES

The Adelphoi Camp is a privately owned association to provide recreational and camping facilities for its members and their guests. The facilities of the association are not available, therefore, on a rental basis.

Use by some groups is allowed through the sponsorship of individual members of the association. These visiting individuals or groups are then considered the guests of the sponsoring member of the association. A member or the association or a member of his family shall personally host the visiting group.

There shall be no scheduling of reservations during the Pennsylvania Deer Hunting Season— the two weeks following Thanksgiving. (Unless by approval of the Association.)

USAGE RESPONSIBILITIES

1. The grounds and cabin facilities are to be maintained in a clean and orderly condition at all times.
2. The leadership of any group shall maintain a controlled and organized atmosphere in the cabin at all times and must be present throughout the groups stay.
3. Food should be restricted largely to the kitchen and dining room areas. If food is to be taken into the lounge area, the leaders should supervise very closely.
4. The bedrooms over the kitchen and dining room areas are for sleeping purposes only. These areas should not be used for any play or food activities.
5. No cutting or marking of any live tree or foliage is permitted.
6. All facilities are to be cleaned and left in good order when vacating the premises.
7. The group will be assessed the cost for any damage incurred and this amount shall be reimbursed to the Association. All damage is also to be reported to the member sponsoring the group.
